

EOGH's chief medical officer passes recertification exam

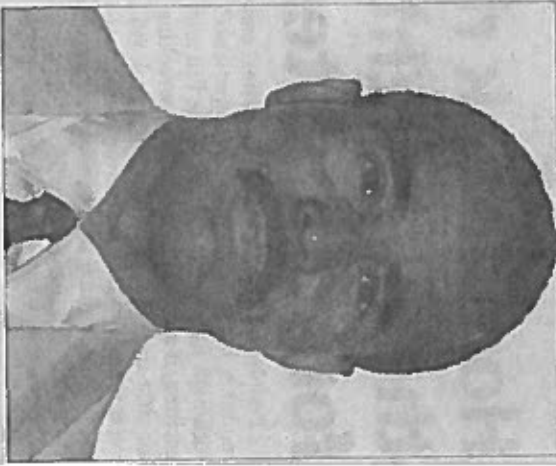
